CONTAINED MOBILITY

Asylum instruments feature highly sophisticated forms of containment through selective and discriminatory mobilities.



REFRAMING OF ASYLUM SEEKERS

Refugees are artificially reframed as forced migrants or temporary protection seekers which challenges the right to asylum.



RIGHTS CURTAILED & INFORMALITY

Human rights violations and rule of law backsliding contrary to legal standards.



CONCEPTS CONTESTING PRINCIPLES

Terms like 'vulnerability', 'self-reliance' and 'solidarity' remain contested and raise exclusionary and state-centric challenges.



RESPONSIBILITY ATTRIBUTION

Asylum governance often blurs responsibility attribution which is recaptured by a systemic responsibility and portable justice model.
